Teaching an "old dog new tricks" Well, this issue I learned how to create "QR codes" like this one:

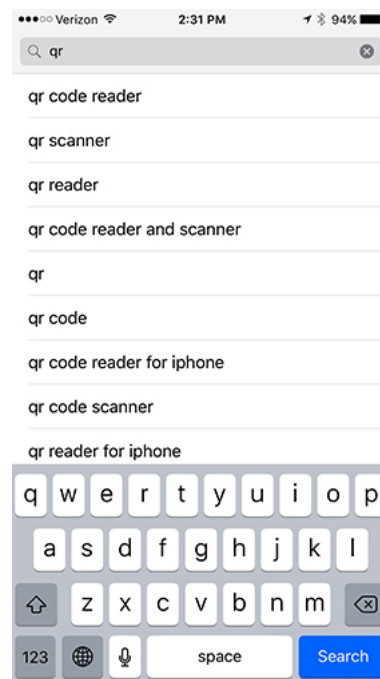
