Well, another MCoR Convention has passed. If you missed the Council Bluffs, IA June 2006 MCoR Convention, you missed a really good one. The contest room had 101 entries and almost 50 of those entries earned a merit award in the AP program. A lot of things happened in the AP program this last six months including getting more MCoR MMR's, but you can read about it in Marty Vaughn's report below. There were more clinics available than you could attend, along with many model and prototype tours. A heart felt thanks to Charles Fennen and his crew that put on the convention. At the convention

MCoR sold their special RI Box cars. These cars can not be reproduced for a number of years, so get your cars from John Averill. Almost 50% of the cars are already gone, so do not delay. I'm pleased to report that a number of you have stepped up and filled some of the directorships on the BOD for some of the vacant Division/Areas. If you would like to volunteer for any open area directors, just contact me, the job is not all that hard to do, and you earn the official certificate after serving three years, just like Brad Slone just accomplished. 29-12, 29-17, 29-20, and 29-21 are in need of directors.

The 2007 convention will be held in conjunction with the Turkey Creek Division Meet next year in the fall usually in August or September. The contest room will be the official MCoR contest and will be open to all NMRA members. They will have a large train show with many sellers. There will be some local model railroads you can visit and some clinics you can attend. The new Convention Chairman, Charles Fennen, will be working with the Division to put on this mini-convention. The BOD has done it this way because no other location was willing to host the 2007 MCoR convention. Charles is actively working on convention sites for 2008, 2009, and 2010. Iowa locations are being investigated, and it is hoped we can visit Oklahoma and Arkansas in future years; we have not been to either state in over ten years. Become a director; let's get these two states up and active again in our region.

Now about region subscriptions, even though MCoR has not raised dues (now a subscription fee) from \$6.00 a year for over 20 years, costs have been increasing! We have a new Caboose Kibitzer Editor, Wendy Harlow, and a new printer/publisher for the CK. Our printing costs have just about doubled and postage costs are up from the USPS. Other MCoR expenses have also increased over the last 20 years. Therefore, effective immediately, the subscription fee for a mailed copy of the CK will be \$12.00 per year, or you can download it from our web site www.mcor-nmra.org for \$8.00 per year, you will need an E-mail address and your MCoR membership number on file in our database before you can download the CK. The NMRA renewal forms will not reflect these changes for several more months, but this increase is in effect NOW! These changes are necessary to keep MCoR financially solvent. I have heard many favorable comments about the new look of the CK. Wendy is doing a great job, and the Caboose Kibitzer is one of the best region publications in the NMRA.

I am looking for another assistant for Whit Johnson, Contest Chairman for the region, to help him in the contest room during our annual convention. Allen Merta has volunteered, Whit's assistant will need to help in the contest room during the convention, but I'm sure with two of you, you can arrange to break away and see a clinic, etc. As things stand right now, Whit is hardly able to leave the contest room during the two day convention. If I can get two assistants for Whit, then all three of you will have more free time. Please volunteer to help Whit!

The minutes of the January 2006 BOD meeting were published by Whit Johnson, MCoR Secretary. A motion to accept the minutes of the January 2006 BOD Meeting as published was made by John Averill, seconded by Ed Bommer.

Treasurer John Shaw gave a report on MCoR Finances. A motion was made to accept the report by John Averill, seconded by Charles Fennen.

PASSED

Sales Manager John Averill reported that the MCoR car project had received 355 cars to date and has sold 28% of the cars.

Directors Reports: Reports were presented as published.

Convention Committee: Charles Fennen, MCoR Convention Committee Chairman addressed the BOD with the fact that no Division or Area has stepped up to host the 2007, MCoR Convention. There was discussion about several solutions and directions the MCoR could consider. A motion was made that the 2007 MCoR Convention be held with Turkey Creek Division's annual meet later in the summer of 2007, by Rick Liebich, seconded by John Averill.

PASSED

Caboose Kibitzer Editor Wendy Harlow reported on the Caboose Kibitzer. The publication is now back on schedule and working to maintain this status. Articles and photos are requested to be submitted to Wendy Harlow for publication. All submitted materials and ads must be in before the deadlines published without exception in order to maintain the schedule.

Marty Vaughn MMR, AP Chairman, reported that there have been 59 AP Certificates processed for MCoR, 8 Golden Spike Awards, and 3 new MMRs. These numbers are since the January 2006 BOD meeting.

Old Business

John Averill, with the recommendation of MCoR Attorney Robert Amsler, made a motion to change Article IV of the MCoR Regulations to read “majority”, in place of “2/3 majority”. Seconded by Larry Alfred.

PASSED

A motion was made by Rick Liebich to set the price for the Caboose Kibitzer at \$8.00, per year for online, and \$12.00 per year hardcopy starting with a member’s next subscription renewal date. Seconded by Larry Alfred.

PASSED

Discussion that the MCoR President addresses the MCoR – TLR boundary with the TLR BOD. The NMRA Regulations state that a 3 digit zip code area is required when region boundaries are modified. There are several region boundaries in the NMRA Regulations that are divided on county lines. This will require a NMRA change as well as a region agreement. A motion was made by Whit Johnson that the MCoR boundary in Iowa would be presented to the TLR and the NMRA as the following counties and all counties South; Dubuque, Delaware, Buchanan, Blackhawk, Grundy, Hardin, Hamilton, Webster, Greene, Guthrie, Audubon, Shelby, and Harrison. Seconded by John Averill.

PASSED

New Business

A motion to approve the Nebraska West Central Division and Turkey Creek Division documents pending approval by the MCoR Attorney, Robert Amsler, was made by Whit Johnson. Seconded by Charles Fennen.

PASSED

A motion was made to adjourn by John Shaw. Seconded by Charles Fennen.
